- 5) Is there anything in your life you feel God can't forgive? (Do a check with your head and your heart. There is often a different answer in these two places as in you "know" the right answer might be no...but where in your heart do you wonder...)
- 6) What steps might you need to take to let God have your brokenness? What steps might you need to take to let God grant you grace?
