Key Questions:

- 1) What does it look like to you to love God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength? Have you ever thought of those areas as: heart=emotionally, soul = spiritually, mind= mentally and strength = physically? If you use those understandings, does it change your answer to the first question? If so, how?

- 2) We have defined authentic community as a place where you can be all of who you are – the good, the bad, the sad, the glad, etc. Where do you have authentic community?

- 3) The mission and vision of FAITH is one that calls us to live missionally... going out into the world. According to Dr. David Fitch in his book “Prodigal Christianity”, “God is at work in all the places we already inhabit. He is bigger than the arena of our own immediate church programs and ideas about evangelism. He is a prodigal God recklessly working in people and situations of all types. If we truly believe God is at work in the world, we must take the time to pay attention, listen, and discern what God is doing in the lives of those around us...” Do you believe this statement? What might it call you into if you took it to heart?

- 4) In Hebrews 11 God tells us the faith story of all the biblical people, isn't complete because your story isn't complete. The journey of faith is one that includes you as well as the “Bible people.” When you think about that, in what ways is your life writing the story of faith for others?
