### How to use Talk It Over:

### Key Questions:

- What do you think it means to be pure in heart?
- In what ways does the inside of your heart match up with the appearances of your life? In what ways doesn't the outside match the inside?
- Peter said that the reason the Bible point out the sin in our lives is because our sin breaks and wounds us. In what ways has your life been broken by sin – your own and the sin of others?
- The pure in heart will see God. Where do you see God at work in the world? Where do you see God working in you and your family? Where do you see God working through you and your family?
