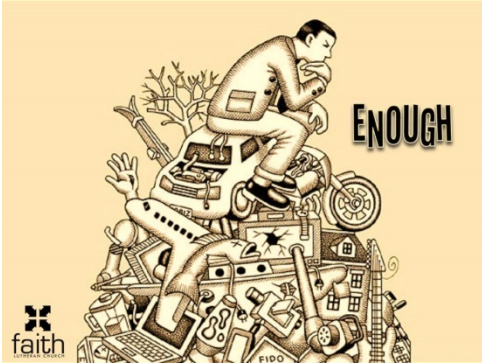

Generosity

How to use Talk It Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your group turn what God is saying to you into action steps. Begin with the key questions, add any optional scriptures and questions if needed, and then wrap up by deciding on your next steps. You can use this study guide with your small group, your family, or on your own.

Today's Key Idea:

Generosity is a mark of a disciple of Jesus; when we live generously with our time and resources, we declare our trust in God to provide.

Key Questions:

- Has anyone ever given sacrificially so you could have something? How has this person impacted your life?
- God has given us things in life that we are “in charge of”. What has God put you “in charge of” in your life and how are you managing it?
- What moves you/motivates you to give?
- In what ways would your life change if you were defined by generosity?
