How to use Talk It Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you and your group turn what God is saying to you into action steps. Begin with the key questions and then wrap up by deciding on your next steps. You can use this study guide with your small group, your family, or on your own.

Key Questions:

- How would you define hero? Who are some heroes in your life?
- A hero is often seen as someone who does something out of the ordinary for a purpose bigger than themselves – saving a life, working tirelessly for the poor, etc. We often see “Bible people’ as people who are larger than life – they are somehow better than we are. But in reality they are simply people trying to follow an extraordinary God. Who has been a hero of faith in your life? Why would you call them a hero? Do they know? If not – what would it be to tell them?
