Tips for Reading this Week:

- Hebrews is also one of the most complex books in the NT. If you get bogged down, focus on the main argument: the new covenant given to us by Jesus is better than the first covenant.
- James, though it starts like a letter, is really a collection of wisdom sayings more like the book of Proverbs. Slow down as you read James and ponder each nugget of wisdom.
- Mark – shortest of the gospels, Mark moves at breakneck speed. Rather than trying to absorb every detail, try reading fast to get the action-packed feel.
