### Tips for Reading this Week:

- John's three letters give a good picture of what the church looked like at the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> century. What do you notice? See if you notice any parallels between these letters and John's gospel.
- Revelation is apocalyptic – writing about the end of times. It has some of the most cryptic imagery in all scripture. Whatever you make of the contents, remember the main message – Stand firm because in the end, God wins and is coming back to dwell with his people.
