Tips for Reading this Week:

- Colossians – Watch as Paul shifts back and forth between practical advice and almost poetry. For example, many scholars think the first paragraph on pg 192 is actually an early Christian hymn.
- Ephesians – take note as Paul encourages converts to Christianity to replace their old way of life with one of purity and integrity.
- Philemon – In this radical letter watch as Paul pleads to Philemon to welcome home his runaway slave – not as a slave but as a dear brother.
- Philippians – This is a book of joy! See if you can count how many times Paul mentions joy in this letter.
- 1&2 Timothy, Titus – These letters reveal Paul's deep love for Timothy, a young man chosen by Paul to be his partner in ministry. Listen for Paul's fatherly advice.
