What Are We Waiting For?

How to use Talk It Over:

Talking through the message during the week helps you turn what God is saying to you into action steps. Begin with the key questions and then wrap up by deciding on your next steps. You can use this study guide with your small group, your family, or on your own.

Key Questions:

- Today starts the season of Advent - a season of waiting and watching. A season to pay attention to the promises of God. Do you know any of the promises God has spoken for you? If so, which ones?
- Re-read this week's lessons: Isaiah 40:3-5 and Revelation 21:1-7. These are both prophecies - one about Jesus' first coming, the second about his second coming and what it will be like. As one who sits in the middle of these two - where do you find comfort?
- Choose a way to mark the days of waiting during Advent. Buy an Advent calendar, make your own, light a candle each day...somehow mark the time of waiting...and rejoice in it.
