Bible Point: God gives us what we need, so...trust God!

Key Verse: "For your Father knows exactly what you need even before you ask Him!" (Matthew 6:8)

Bible Story: God Provides Manna and Quail. (Exodus 16)

After watching the video of the story, have a Bible handy. You can have older children who are readers find this story in the Bible. Have them help you read the story out of the Bible.
